



SEVEN SLEEPERS

BAROSSA VALLEY SHIRAZ 2021

SEVEN SLEEPERS SHIRAZ IS A BRIGHT, FRUIT DRIVEN WINE WITH PURE BAROSSA FLAVOURS OF CHERRIES AND PLUMS. SWEET, MOUTHFILLING FRUIT DOMINATES, WHILE SILKY, RIPE TANNINS GIVE THE WINE A LINGERING FINISH.

The Kurtz family are sixth generation Barossan's of German descent. The original Kurtz Family Vineyard was planted in the 1930s, with vines still in use today. Later plantings and acquisitions in the fifties and sixties, allow fifth generation vigneron, Steve Kurtz, to draw on significant old-vine fruit to create a range of wines that are fine examples of the traditional Barossa style - full flavoured reds that are rich on the nose and palate.

Seven Sleepers, or Siebenschlaffer, is named after an old Barossa German farmers' lore, being that the weather that occurs on 27 June is likely to be prevalent for the next 7 weeks.

WINE DETAILS

Fruit for Seven Sleepers Shiraz 2021 was grown on the **VINEYARDS** Kurtz Family vineyard at Light Pass in the Barossa Valley.

The vines receive minimal irrigation and are pruned for vine balance, resulting in maximum fruit quality and varietal

expression.

GROWING SEASON Relatively good rainfall in Autumn, and again towards the

end of Spring, soil moisture was generally at good levels going into Summer. This, along with reasonably cool summer temperatures, meant the vines were healthy; a good number of bunches set, and berry size remained at

optimum levels for high quality wine grape production.

WINE ANALYSIS Alc/Vol: 14.5% | Acidity: 6.2 g/L | pH: 3.57

PEAK DRINKING The rich combination of sweet, mouthfilling flavours is

ideally suited to current consumption, however the wine

will also reward careful short-term cellaring.

FOOD MATCH Seven Sleepers Shiraz is a great match with grilled,

pan-fried, barbecued or roasted meats, pasta, pizza and

other full-flavoured dishes.

TASTING NOTES

COLOUR Bright purple-red with crimson hues.

NOSE A bright, lively, fruit-driven wine with

dominant aromas of plum, cherry and mint chocolate, with hints of violet and

toasted almonds.

PALATE Juicy dark fruits fill the palate, with a

> touch of oak that supports but doesn't dominate, allowing the dark fruit to show its full potential. Fine, ripe tannins give length, with a finish that's silky, yet gently structured, with

delicious, lingering flavour.
